Meeting ECO goals can be challenging since some commute options are off the table. Telecommuting doesn't work for production facilities and public transportation isn't available during all shifts.

West Linn Paper Company has embraced compressed work schedules for nearly all production and maintenance staff. They also provide locker rooms and showers to support walking and biking and offer telecommuting when job responsibilities allow it.

Employee Transportation Coordinator, Penny Machinski, has heard a lot of positive feedback over the years about the compressed work week schedule. "People say positive things about how much they can get done when they have days off during the week. They can schedule doctor's appointments, volunteer at their children's school, even go mid-week skiing."
