

- We can't take your recycling because:
- Just a reminder:

These items are a problem to recycling facilities and should be disposed of properly:

- Plastic bags or stretchy plastic film** — take these items to participating grocers for recycling
- Rigid and hard plastics** — clamshells, trays, toys, or similar — take these items to a drop-off recycling center near you. Call ahead to confirm recycling availability
- Food-soiled containers, paper, tissues, napkins, paper towels or liquid** — rinse containers before recycling — dispose of food-soiled in the garbage

Other items not accepted in your roll cart

- Hazardous product containers, compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs)
- Plastic lids, tops and caps
- Styrofoam™ blocks, packaging peanuts, meat trays
- Light bulbs, mirror or window glass, ceramics, vases (bag and place in garbage)
- Wood/yard debris
- Diapers or pet waste
- Garbage

Incorrectly prepared for collection

- Glass wasn't on the side. Glass bottles and jars must be separate from other materials in a yellow recycling bin or other rigid, reusable container labeled Glass Only.
- Container is not within 3 feet of the curb
- Cardboard must be flattened and/or bundled (no more than 36 inches in any direction)
- Metal was too long (must be less than 30") or too heavy (more than 30 lbs.) or wasn't clean or free of rubber, plastic or other materials
- Used motor oil in wrong container. Use a leak-proof, see-through plastic container with screw-on lid (like milk jug)
- Used motor oil was mixed with other liquid. No water, gasoline, antifreeze or other fluids
