## Used Oil Marketers Checklist

**Please note: This document is utilized by DEQ used oil inspectors during site inspections and is provided here for informational purposes only.**

### Purpose and Explanation

40 CFR Part 279, Subpart H identifies the requirements that apply to used oil marketers. A used oil marketer is any person who directs a shipment of off-specification used oil from their facility to a used oil burner or first claims the used oil that is to be burned for energy recovery meets the used oil fuel specifications set forth in § 279.11.

Subpart H does not apply to used oil generators and transporters who transport used oil received only from generators, unless the generator or transporter directs a shipment of off-specification used oil from their facility to a used oil burner. This part also does not apply to person who directs shipments of on-specification used oil or who is not the first person to claim the oil meets the used oil fuel specifications of § 279.11.

Oregon has adopted the federal regulations that pertain to used oil management pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rule 340-100-0002.
