

## DEQ appoints new committee members

The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality Director Dick Pederson appointed David Stone as a new member of the Air Toxics Science Advisory Committee and Todd Hudson as a reserve member. On April 15, 2015, the Oregon Environmental Quality Commission approved these appointments.

### David Stone

David Stone is an associate professor in the Department of Environmental and Molecular Toxicology at Oregon State University. He directs the National Pesticide Information Center, a cooperative agreement between the university and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. He also holds an appointment in Extension Services, where he engages diverse stakeholders on issues related to pesticide exposure, integrated pest management, risk assessment, and risk communication. Stone has served on several state and national scientific advisory panels and is a past president of the Pacific Northwest Association of Toxicologists. In addition, he teaches courses on toxicology and biotechnology, is a co-leader in the Research Translation Core of Oregon State University's Superfund Program, and is an investigator in a Multicultural Scholars Program for underrepresented students. Before joining Oregon State University, Stone served as a state toxicologist for the Oregon Health Authority. He received his MS from the University of North Texas and his PhD in toxicology from Oregon State University.

Stone replaces Kim Anderson, who resigned from the committee in early February, 2015.

### Todd Hudson

Todd Hudson is a public health toxicologist in Oregon Health Authority's Environmental Health Assessment Program, and has been with the agency since 2011. He has five years experience working in environmental public health, and several years experience working for environmental consulting firms. Todd received a Master of Public Health from the Texas A&M University Health Sciences Center and a Bachelor of Science from Grand Valley State University in Michigan. Todd has expertise in human health risk assessment, toxicology, exposure assessment, environmental epidemiology, and risk communication.
