


First Quarter 2016 Data Summary


DEQ staff are pleased to issue the first quarterly data summary for the Clean Fuels Program. DEQ has reviewed all of the first quarter data reports, but there might be slight changes to the data as DEQ continues to work with regulated parties on revisions to their initial reporting. The aggregated quarterly data for the program will also be posted on our website in an Excel worksheet format. In the future, DEQ will post a summary of each quarters' data and an update to the spreadsheet that includes the past quarters' data.

The first graph shows the number of credits and deficits generated. Credits are generated by fuels whose carbon intensity falls below this year's target, while deficits are generated by fuels whose carbon intensity is higher than this year's target. Over 159,000 credits were generated in the first quarter versus around 140,000 deficits.



The second graph shows the breakdown in the first quarter of what fuels generated credits. The majority of credits came from ethanol and biodiesel that are blended into gasoline and diesel, respectively. The other category includes alternative fuels such as natural gas, biogas and electricity.

Approximately 80 businesses reported to DEQ in the first quarter of 2016, representing Oregon producers of ethanol and biodiesel; importers of gasoline, diesel, ethanol and biodiesel; natural gas and propane fueling stations; electric vehicle charging stations and producers of biogas.
