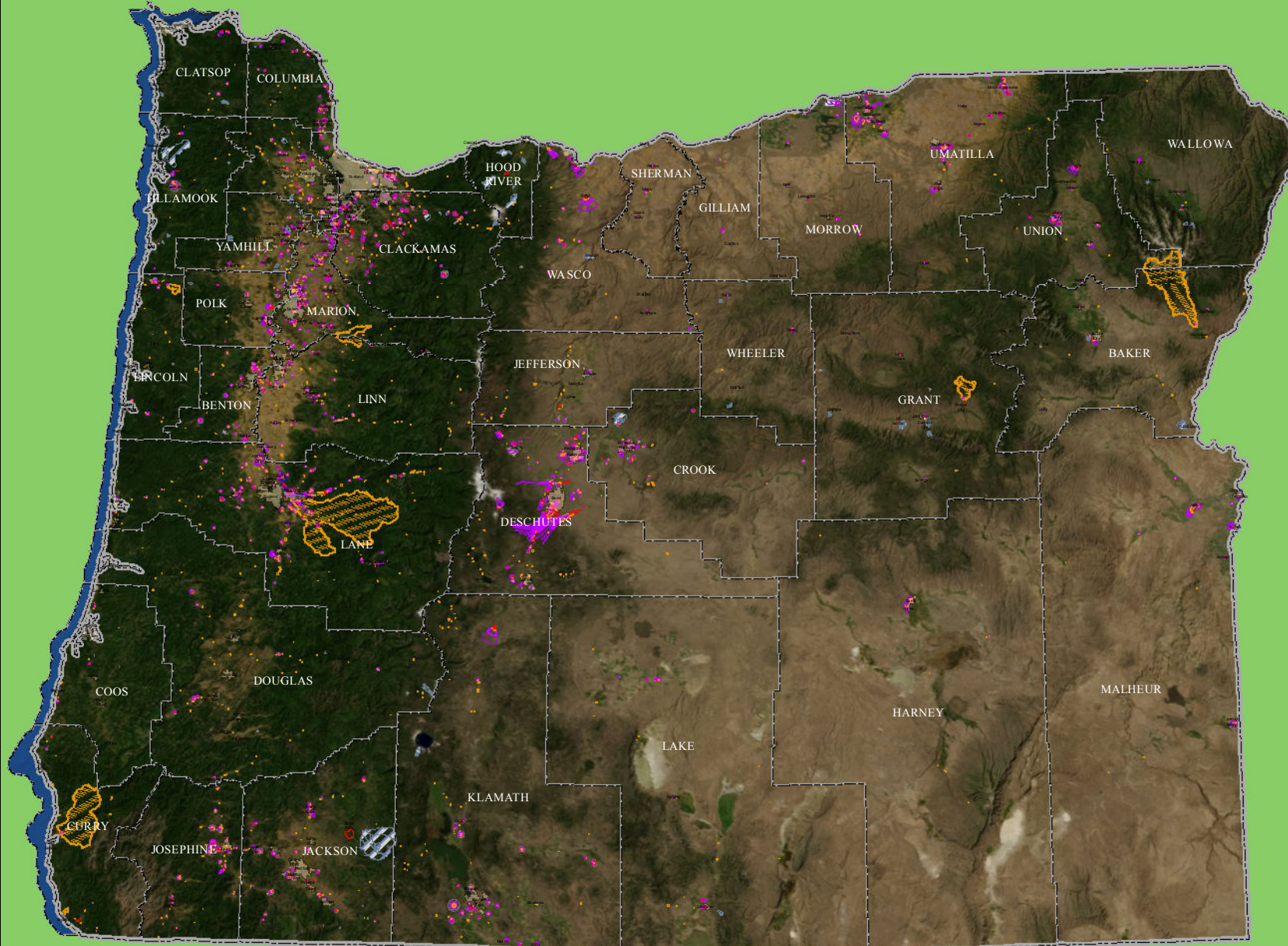
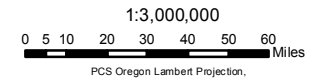
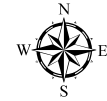















Oregon Public Water Systems Groundwater Drinking Water Source Areas
