Black/Trash Red/Recycling Green/Yard Debris



CART ISSUES

- There was a spacing and/or location issue.
(SEE DIAGRAM ABOVE FOR CORRECT SPACING)
- Your cart is too full. Please remove material so the lid will close.

TRASH CONTAMINATION

- Please bag easily scattered materials like Styrofoam peanuts, kitty litter and pet waste.
- Hazardous materials were found in your cart:
 - No fluorescent tube lights or bulbs
 - No liquids or paints
 - Other _____

RECYCLING CONTAMINATION

- No plastic (**except** milk jug style containers)
- No plastic bags or wrap
- No mixed paper (office paper, mail, magazines, cereal boxes)
- No glass
- No Styrofoam
- No trash

YARD DEBRIS CONTAMINATION

- No bark, dirt, rocks or sod
- No plastic bags or nursery pots
- No trash

**WHAT GOES IN THE RED LID
RECYCLING CART?**

YES! These CAN go in your cart.



Cardboard
(the kind with the wavy center)



Newspaper and Inserts
(no magazines)



Milk Jug Style Containers
(clear or white, rinsed out, no lids)



Tin and Aluminum Cans
(rinsed out, no lids)

NO! If it's not a yes, it CAN'T go!

KEEP IT LOOSE!

Please do NOT bag your recyclables.
Just toss them directly into your cart.

Remember, when in doubt, leave it out!

**WHAT GOES IN THE GREEN LID
YARD DEBRIS CART?**

**YES! These items CAN go in
your green-lid cart**



**Garden waste, grass,
and floral clippings**



**Vegetation and
weeds**



Leaves



**Brush and woody
material up to 4"
diameter and 48"
long**

Do NOT bag your yard debris

**NO! These items CANNOT go in
your green-lid cart**

- No bark, dirt, rocks or sod
- No plastic bags or nursery pots
- No trash
