Reissuance Overview

- Current permit became effective Aug. 1, 2017
- Permit reissued upon reconsideration on Oct. 22, 2018
- Permit expires on July 31, 2022
- Visit our [website](#) for additional information

Industrial Stormwater 1200-Z

Conditions which did not change

- Permit expiration date
- Second year geometric mean or Tier II evaluation year
- DMR supporting documentation
- TMDL and 303(d) list frozen in time
- Tier I investigation response

Industrial Stormwater 1200-Z

Noteworthy Changes

- Change of Regional total zinc benchmark to 0.12 mg/L
- Impairment exceedance – Tier I reports sent to DEQ or Agent
- Quarterly DMR submission deadlines
- Clarification to monitoring variances submittals
- Increased monitoring frequencies
- Increased awareness on TMDLs and impaired waterbodies

Industrial Stormwater 1200-Z

Monitoring Frequency

- Impairment pollutants must be monitored four times per year
- Numeric effluent limitation change: two times per year
- Monitoring year spans: July 1 through June 30
- Two distinct semi-annual frequencies:
 - July 1 – December 31
 - January 1 – June 30

Industrial Stormwater 1200-Z

Discharge Monitoring Reports

- No DMR due on Nov. 15, 2018
- First quarterly DMR due Feb. 15, 2019
 - July 1, 2018, thorough December 31, 2018, data reported in the 2nd quarter DMR, February 2019
- DMR form has been updated

DMR Continued

- Annual DMR reports are a thing of the past

Reporting Quarters	Months	DMR Due Dates
1 st	July-September	November 15
2 nd	October-December	February 15 [*]
3 rd	January-March	May 15
4 th	April-June	August 15 [*]

*Variance request may be submitted semi-annually as applicable

Industrial Stormwater 1200-Z

DMR Submittals and Tier II Evaluation

- August 15, 2019, DMR calculate geometric mean
- All previous data shown from February 2019, and May 2019
- Otherwise, don't need to report previous data
- Depending on permit assignment – different Tier II years

Industrial Stormwater 1200-Z

Monitoring Variances

- Documentation included with February and August DMRs
- Must submit supporting documents with DMR
- For no storm event to produce run-off
- May need to include volume reduction calculations
