## Advisory Committee Meeting

**Objective:** Advisory committee members will discuss and identify best management practices specific to different nonpoint sources of mercury and how to track implementation of best management practices. To best facilitate contribution from all committee members, DEQ will facilitate a breakout session during which the committee will form small groups. Only committee members or their alternates will take part in this three step exercise.

This exercise will provide advisory committee members an opportunity to discuss and strategize with one another about nonpoint source implementation. The March meeting in Tangent set the stage in terms of what is currently being implemented. A natural follow-up is to have advisory committee members brainstorm and identify potential next steps for implementation.

It will be most helpful to have familiarity with types of BMPs used for agriculture, forest and urban land use types. DEQ will provide handouts during the meeting to guide discussions.

It should be noted that our discussion will include urban areas that are not NPDES permitted Municipal Separate Stormwater Sewer Systems. The advisory committee will have an opportunity to discuss issues related to DEQ regulated point sources, including MS4s, at a later meeting.
