C. Certification

I also understand that the submittal of this Notice of Termination does not release an operator from liability for any violations of this permit or the Clean Water Act.

I certify under penalty of law that this document and all attachments were prepared under my direction or supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate the information submitted. Based on my inquiry of the person or persons who manage the system, or those persons directly responsible for gathering the information, the information submitted is, to the best of my knowledge and belief, true, accurate, and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment for knowing violations.

Notice of Termination Instructions

Who May File a Notice of Termination (NOT) Form?

Permit registrants who are presently covered under an Oregon Department of Environmental Quality NPDES Industrial Stormwater Discharge General Permit Nos. 1200-Z or 1200-A may submit this form when their facilities no longer have any stormwater discharges associated with industrial activity as defined in the stormwater regulations at 40 CFR 122.26(b)(14), or when they are no longer the operator of the facility, or coverage under and individual NPDES permit has been obtained.

A. Facility Information

1. Give the legal name of the person, firm, public organization, or any other entity that operates the facility or site described in this application.
2. The name of the facility contact may or may not be the same name as the legal contact.
- 3/4. Enter the complete address and telephone number of the legal and facility contact.
5. Enter the existing NPDES Stormwater General Permit number (e.g. 1200-Z or 1200-A)
6. Enter the DEQ File number provided to the facility when you registered for coverage under the permit. The DEQ file number can be found on the first page of your permit. If you do not know the permit or file number, contact DEQ regional office or DEQ Agents.

B. Reason for submitting Notice of Termination

Please complete one or more of the conditions described in this section and provide a brief narrative description of the reason of termination. Reasons for termination include:

- You are no longer the operator of the facility or site.
- There are no industrial activities at the site that require permit coverage.
- All stormwater discharges associated with industrial activities at the facility or site have ceased.
- Coverage under an individual NPDES permit has been obtained.

C. Certification

Federal statutes provide for severe penalties for submitting false information on this application form. Federal regulations require this application to be signed as follows:

- For a corporation: by a responsible corporate officer, which means (I) president, secretary, treasurer, or vice president of the corporation in charge of a principal business function, or any other person who performs similar policy or decision making functions, or (II) the manager of one or more manufacturing, production or operating facilities employing more than 250 persons or having gross annual sales or expenditures exceeding \$25 million (in second-quarter 1980 dollars) if authority to sign documents has been assigned or delegated to the manager in accordance with corporate procedures; or
- For a partnership or sole proprietorship: by a general partner or the proprietor; or
- For a municipality, State, Federal, or other public facility: by either a principal executive officer or ranking elected official.
