

Asbestos Fee Increase - 2025

Starting July 29, 2025, a 3% fee increase for the Asbestos Program that will take effect This increase helps cover rising operational costs and allows the program to maintain essential services that protect public and worker health. These services include technical assistance, inspecting abatement projects, working with partner agencies, and investigating violations.

State law allows DEQ to increase fees annually by either 3% or the actual cost increase to run the program—whichever is less.
