OHA conducted a **public health assessment** to evaluate potential health risks from contaminants in water, soil and air at or near the PCC facility.

Public Health Assessment

The **Air Toxics Summary Report** summarizes air toxics data collected by DEQ at six monitoring sites across Oregon, including one site near the PCC facility at 45th & Harney

Informative and examines data from monitor at 45th & Harney

Air Toxics Summary Report

Next steps involve coordination with CAO

The **Air Quality Permit** is a contract between DEQ and the PCC facility that limits emissions and instates operational and monitoring requirements.

Cleaner Air Oregon

Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) is a new DEQ program that requires facilities to evaluate potential health risks from their emissions and reduce their emissions if risk levels exceed health guidelines.
