***Physical availability:** A sewer system is considered physically available if connection is not physically impractical and its nearest sewer connection point from the property to be served is:

Type of septic permit or development in gallons per day (gpd) projected daily sewage flow	Nearest sewer connection point must be within:
Repair or Alteration Permit up to 899 gpd	200 feet
Construction-Installation Permit up to 899 gpd	300 feet
Proposed subdivision or group of two to five single family dwellings or equivalent	200 feet multiplied by the number of dwelling equivalents, maximum 1000 feet
Proposed subdivision or development with more than five single-family dwellings or equivalent	Onsite agent makes case-by-case determination of physical sewer availability

****Legal availability:** A sewer system shall be deemed legally available if the sewer connection is accessible by a right-of-way or existing easement and available by local ordinance. OAR 340-071-0160(4)(f) requires denial of a septic permit if a sewer system that can accommodate the proposed sewage flow is both physically* and legally** available.
