


Nomenclature

- Anthropogenic: emissions from man made processes or emissions from man made activities (for example emissions from a factory's smokestack or cows at a dairy)
- Non-anthropogenic: emissions from wildfires and biogenics (vegetation and soil)
- **Point Source:** emissions from larger, fixed sources. They are commercial, industrial, and institutional facilities that have individual air quality permits with Oregon DEQ. Examples are factories and power plants.
- **Nonpoint Source:** emissions from many small sources grouped together. For example: wood stoves, dry cleaners, gas stations, stationary engines and generators, and the use of chemicals (such as paints and cleaners).
- Road: emissions from onroad vehicles that burn fuel, includes light duty and heavy duty vehicles.
- Nonroad: emissions from off-road vehicles that burn fuel, includes construction equipment, lawn and garden equipment, locomotives, and commercial marine vessels.
- Event: emissions from wildfires and prescribed burns.




Carbon Monoxide






Carbon Monoxide Anthropogenic






Ammonia






Ammonia Anthropogenic





Nitrogen Oxides






Nitrogen Oxides Anthropogenic






Sulfur Dioxide






Sulfur Dioxide Anthropogenic






Volatile Organic Compounds






Volatile Organic Compounds Anthropogenic






Particulate Mater 2.5
