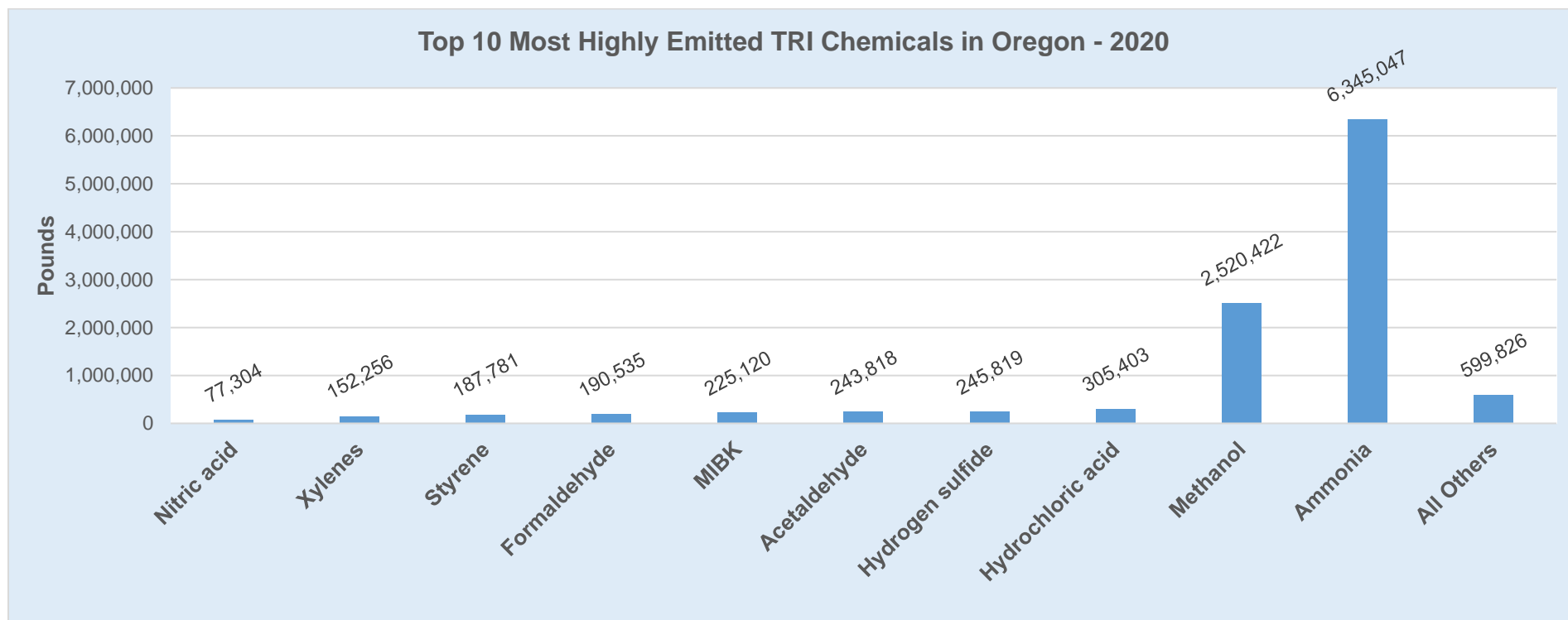

Top 10 Most Highly Emitted TRI Chemicals in Oregon - 2020



This bar chart presents emission amounts (in pounds per year) of the 10 TRI chemicals emitted in the highest amounts in Oregon in 2019, whether from a single facility or many facilities. As you can see, ammonia and methanol were emitted in much higher amounts than the other eight chemicals shown above. The last bar in the chart represents the combined emissions of all other TRI chemicals in Oregon in 2019 that were not one of the 10 most highly-emitted chemicals.
