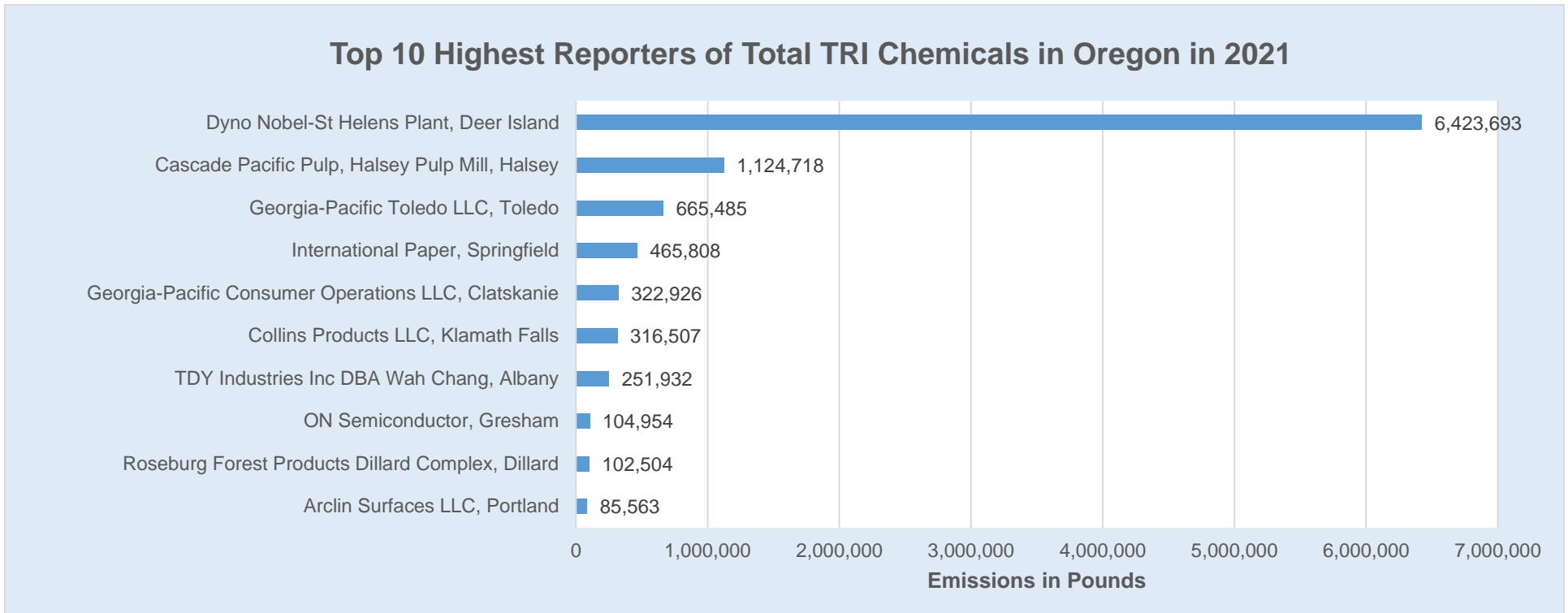


Top 10 Highest Reporters of Total TRI Chemicals in Oregon - 2021



This bar chart presents the amounts of total TRI emissions released by the ten highest TRI reporters (TRI facilities) in Oregon in 2021. Total TRI emissions mean each facility's emissions contain multiple TRI chemicals, although some facility emissions contain a high percentage of one or two TRI chemicals in particular, such as ammonia from the Dyno Nobel facility.
