



What is air quality monitoring?

Air quality regulations:

 Limits air pollutants and sets air quality standards based on a standard measurement of chemicals and compounds in the air

Air quality monitoring regulations:

- Ensures that air monitoring data is high quality, complete and comparable nationwide
- Ensures the highest standard equipment is used – and quality standards for how to use that equipment
- Creates standards for reporting data to inform program and the local rules

Community data


What is community data? What does it tell us?

Community data mapping


Assets, Needs, Concerns

- Memory and Identity recognizable landmarks and places with a strong sense of connection




