

Air quality monitoring data can support community


decision making.

Sensor host benefits

- Participate in real scientific data collection
- Help your community
- Stipend





Sensor host expectations

- Begin hosting as soon as possible
- Host sensor will end Oct 1, 2025
- Keep sensor must in one location





Sensor host expectations

- Provide suitable location for the sensor
- Provide 120V power to the sensor (from wall outlet)
- Provide Wi-Fi to the sensor





Sensor host expectations

- Document installation and inspections
- Send photographs of installed sensor
- Inspect sensor every two weeks
- Clean sensor as needed

- Know why you want to monitor
- Know when you want to monitor






Sensor placement

Areas of Concern = Sticky Notes


Possible Monitors = Orange Dots
