Mr. Hughes,

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has completed our review of the additional emissions inventory information submitted by the Collins Pine facility in Lakeview, OR on February 19, 2020 and March 4, 2020 as part of the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) program.

In the February submittal, Collins Pine addressed the majority of comments in DEQ's response to the emissions inventory submitted on November 25, 2019, including furnishing safety data sheets (SDSs) DEQ requested. Based on DEQ's review, two items were revised in the March submittal:

- The percentage of hexane in tree marking paint reported in the emissions inventory was revised to reflect the midpoint of the range provided on the SDS, and
- Equation (f) of Table 1 of the supporting calculations prepared by Maul Foster Alongi was revised to have units consistent with the emissions reported.

In accordance with OAR 340-245-0210(1), this letter provides written notice to you that DEQ has reviewed and approves the CAO emissions inventory submitted in March.

The next step in the CAO process is to begin a risk assessment for your facility. Submit a modeling protocol to DEQ by April 8, 2020. Modeling protocol requirements are listed in OAR 340-245-0210(1)(a). If you plan to complete a level 3 or 4 risk assessment, your risk assessment work plan (RAWP) must be submitted to DEQ by May 8, 2020. RAWP requirements are listed in OAR 340-245-0210(2).
