DEQ has reviewed the Response to Comments (Response) submitted by ENTEK International LLC (ENTEK) on August 17, 2022, in response to the DEQ comment letter issued on August 2, 2022. In that letter DEQ requested that ENTEK provide additional information, corrections, and updates to the revised Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) Modeling Protocol, submitted on June 24, 2022, and the Risk Assessment Work Plan (Work Plan), originally submitted on March 18, 2022. DEQ approves both the revised Modeling Protocol and revised Work Plan.

In regard to DEQ's comment requesting that ENTEK submit AQ521 and AQ522 forms in order to exclude the exposure locations on Taxlot 1400 (Map Number 12S2W03C) from the modeling analysis, DEQ will not require submittal of these forms at this time in order to allow these exposure locations to be excluded from the risk assessment. However, DEQ notes that in the future, if the public is able to access this property regularly, either because ENTEK has sold this property or is no longer restricting access by maintaining the required fencing, then DEQ will require an updated risk assessment to include these exposure locations.

The next step in this process is to submit the Level 3 Risk Assessment **120 days** from the issuance of this approval letter, by no later than **December 24, 2022**.
