DEQ received your submittal in response to DEQ's information request regarding Exempt Toxics Emissions Units (TEUs) dated June 7, 2022 and your revised Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) Toxic Air Contaminant Emissions Inventory (Inventory) dated July 14, 2022. These documents were submitted for the EcoLube Recovery, LLC (EcoLube) facility in Portland, OR. DEQ has completed our final review.

The information that you provided on June 7, 2022, is sufficient to demonstrate that activities or operations at your facility no longer defined as Categorical Exempt TEUs under the CAO program [OAR 340-245-0060(3)] meet the criteria in OAR 340-245-0060(3)(a) to remain Exempt TEUs. Further, the information is sufficient to meet the reporting requirements for Exempt TEUs under OAR 340-245-0040(4)(a).

In accordance with OAR 340-245-0210(a), this letter also provides notice to you that DEQ has reviewed and approves the revised Inventory dated July 14, 2022.

The next step in the CAO process is to submit the Modeling Protocol by no later than November 28, 2022 and Risk Assessment Work Plan, if you plan to submit a Level 3 Risk Assessment, no later than December 26, 2022. [OAR 340-245-0030(1)(b)&(c)]
