Re: Response to ORRCO-IOI Klamath Falls Deadline Extension Requests

Ms. Piper,

The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received written notification from you on behalf of Oil Re-Refining Company (ORRCO) on April 10, 2020, requesting an extension of time for submittal of the May 1st revised emissions inventory and June 15th source test deadlines for the ORRCO facility in Klamath Falls, Oregon. DEQ understands that ORRCO would like a 45-day extension to each of these submittal timelines for the following reasons:

1. ORRCO demonstrated progress in information presented to DEQ in a meeting on April 6, 2020.
2. More work must be done to obtain accurate emissions information for fuel oil combustion at ORRCO's Klamath Falls facility and revise storage tank emission factors
3. Additional time is needed to accommodate for challenges in acquiring information from third parties during this unprecedented pandemic.

DEQ approves ORRCO's request for a 45-day extension for the revised emissions inventory and source test deadline with the presumption that ORRCO will communicate any questions or clarifications proactively in order to provide timely and complete submittals. The revised emissions inventory shall be submitted no later than June 15, 2020. Source testing shall be completed no later than July 30, 2020.
