Re: Follow-Up to Cleaner Air Oregon Emissions Inventory Extension Request

Ms. Uchytel,

On August 4, 2020, the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) requested that Precision Castparts Large Parts Campus (PCC-LPC) revise and resubmit by September 3, 2020 their emissions inventory and process flow and site diagrams to align with the TEU definition in OAR 340-245-0020(61).

On August 26, 2020, DEQ spoke with PCC-LPC on a conference call to discuss the feasibility of an extension request for the following emissions inventory submittals:

1. Providing the revised emissions inventory based on the "Requested Potential To Emit" (PTE) emissions calculations (Requested PTE EI) by September 3, 2020.
2. Providing the revised emissions inventory based on the 2018 actual production activity (2018 EI) emission calculations after resolving comments on the Requested PTE EI submitted in (1).

DEQ approves the following updated submittal schedule:

1. Submit the Requested PTE EI by September 3, 2020, along with the revised process flow and site diagrams requested in our August 4, 2020 letter by this date.
2. Submit a final updated emissions inventory incorporating both the 2018 EI and Requested PTE EI emissions estimates 30 days after approval of calculation methods used in the Requested PTE EI.
