Steven Petrin,

DEQ received the submittal of the revised Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) Emissions Inventory for the Stimson Lumber Company (Stimson) in Gaston, OR on March 24, 2023, and has completed a review. On March 28, 2023, DEQ provided Stimson with a revised version of the Inventory AQ520 form which included DEQ's minor corrections to the maximum daily emissions for the FORMER_STK and FORMER_FUG Toxic Emissions Units (TEUs). On March 28, 2023, Maul Foster Alongi indicated approval of DEQ's corrections and the revised AQ520 form, on behalf of Stimson.

DEQ has reviewed and approves the Emissions Inventory provided to Stimson by DEQ on March 28, 2023.

The next step in the CAO process is to submit the Modeling Protocol no later than thirty (30) days after the date of this letter, by April 28, 2023. [OAR 340-245-0030(1)(b)] Modeling Protocol requirements are listed in OAR 340-245-0210(1)(a). If you plan to complete a Level 3 or 4 Risk Assessment, your Risk Assessment Work Plan (RAWP) must be submitted to DEQ by no later than sixty (60) days from the date of this letter, by May 29, 2023. [OAR 340-245-0030(1)(c)] RAWP requirements are listed in OAR 340-245-0210(2).
