Dear Marissa,

Wolf Steel Foundry informed the DEQ in a meeting on May 18, 2023, that operations would be shutting down in the near future, and would eventually be requesting termination of its Simple ACDP (Permit No. 03-0016-SI-01). Wolf melted and poured the final heat on May 19 but will continue certain finishing activities, including preparing for shipment, potentially until July 31, 2023. Wolf will submit another letter once activities have ceased requesting termination of permit coverage. Additionally, Wolf has been proceeding with DEQ through the Cleaner Air Oregon process. Please consider this process to be terminated as it does not make sense to continue at this point with a pending closure.

As discussed during the May 18 meeting with DEQ, the other operations on the same property in Hubbard are permitted under a General ACDP for Ulven Forging (Source No. 03-0083, AQGP-029). This was determined by DEQ in a letter dated September 15, 2011, with Wolf Steel Foundry being determined to be a separate source. Ulven Forging will continue to operate.
