Dear Mr. Hughes,

DEQ has reviewed the information submitted in response to the information request regarding Exempt Toxics Emissions Units (TEUs) issued to you on April 12, 2022. The information that you provided did not include two reportable toxic air contaminants (TACs) (acetone and hexavalent chromium present in Strust SSPR Gloss Sunburst Yellow and welding fumes, respectively). DEQ corrected your emissions estimates in the attached spreadsheet. The revised calculations are sufficient to demonstrate that activities or operations at your facility no longer defined as Categorically Exempt TEUs under the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) program [OAR 340-245-0060(3)] meet the criteria in OAR 340-245-0060(3)(a) to remain Exempt TEUs. Further, the revised information is sufficient to meet the reporting requirements for Exempt TEUs under OAR 340-245-0040(4)(a).
