EcoLube Recovery is requesting a two week extension of our original submittal deadline of March 28<sup>th</sup> 2022. EcoLube Recovery is requesting that this deadline be moved to April 11<sup>th</sup> 2022. The delay is a result of the below cause:

- Due to a delay at the third party lab that Montrose submitted all source test samples for CAO and ADCP testing, the results from these samples will not come back in time for EcoLube to process the data by the current deadline of March 28<sup>th</sup> 2022. EcoLube has checked in with Montrose on a regular basis, in regards to the status of the lab. The lab notified EcoLube on March 20<sup>th</sup> 2022, that the estimated date the CAO and ADCP testing results would be available to EcoLube Recovery is March 25<sup>th</sup> 2022.

Given the proposed submittal deadline extension of April 11<sup>th</sup> 2022, EcoLube Recovery will be able to submit a more accurate and complete analysis of the CAO and ADCP testing to the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality.
