Ms. Piper,

DEQ received the submittal of the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) Dispersion Modeling and Risk Assessment Protocol (Protocol) for the Oil Re-Refining Company, Inc. facility in Klamath Falls, OR dated September 22, 2021 and has completed an initial review.

In accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 340-245-0030(2), DEQ has determined that the following additional information, corrections, and updates are required by **November 24, 2021** in order to approve the Protocol:

- 1. **Figure 2**: Please review and revise the property boundary to match the taxlot (MTL 3909-00900-00302; PROP ID 872446) as provided by the Klamath County Land Use Zoning Map<sup>1</sup>. The east side of the facility as depicted in the Protocol does not appear to match the taxlot area.
- 2. **Nearest worker receptor**: Please evaluate worker exposure at the property boundary as the properties adjacent to the facility are zoned for heavy industrial use.
- 3. **Supplemental figure:** Add a supplemental figure showing a close-up aerial view of TEU locations, with each TEU labeled.

DEQ is requesting that you submit additional information to complete your Protocol. If you think that any of that information is confidential, trade secret or otherwise exempt from disclosure, in whole or in part, you must comply with the requirements in OAR 340-214-0130 to identify this information. This includes clearly marking each page of the writing with a request for exemption from disclosure and stating the specific statutory provision under which you claim exemption. Emissions data is not exempt from disclosure.

DEQ remains available to discuss the information request with you and answer any questions you may have. Failure to provide additional information, corrections, or updates to DEQ by the deadlines above may result in a violation of OAR 340-245-0030(1).
