Re: Response to ORRICO-IOI Klamath Falls Additional Deadline Extension Request

Ms. Piper,

The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received written notification from you on behalf of Oil Re-Refining Company (ORRICO) dated September 10, 2020, requesting an extension of time for submittal of the source test report summarizing testing conducted August 25-26, 2020 at the ORRICO facility in Klamath Falls.

DEQ understands that ORRICO would like to extend the source test report due date by 60 days for the following reason: the analytical lab performing source test sample analyses indicated that because some analytical procedures associated with EPA Method 23 are new, additional time is required to develop and proof their laboratory techniques. The analytical process may take up to five weeks to complete.

DEQ grants ORRICO a 30-day extension for source test report submittal. The source test report is due no later than **November 24, 2020**.
