The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received the submittal of the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) Toxic Air Contaminant Emissions Inventory (Inventory) submitted by Cascade Environmental Management (Cascade) on behalf of the Oil Re-Refining Company (ORRCO) facility in Klamath Falls, Oregon, on August 24, 2021 and has completed our review.

In accordance with 340-245-0040, this letter provides written notice to you that DEQ has reviewed and approves the Emissions Inventory submitted on August 24, 2021.

The next step in the CAO process is to begin a risk assessment for your facility. In accordance with OAR 340-245-0030(1)(b), the Modeling Protocol must be submitted to DEQ by **September 27, 2021**. Modeling Protocol requirements are listed in OAR 340-245-0210(1)(a). If you plan to complete a Level 3 or 4 Risk Assessment, your Risk Assessment Work Plan (RAWP) must be submitted to DEQ by **October 26, 2021**. RAWP requirements are listed in OAR 340-245-0210(2).
