



Modernizing Oregon E-Cycles: Amendment to HB 3220

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The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality engaged with the public over five workshops beginning in July 2022 to develop a legislative concept to improve the popular Oregon E-Cycles program and ensure its success for years to come. Workshop participants included the Consumer Technology Association, Oregon Refuse & Recycling Association, local governments, and current and past E-Cycles operators, collection sites and processors.

The content of the original legislative concept developed last fall and presented in the workshops has been introduced in House Bill 3220. DEQ will seek an amendment to HB 3220 that reflects input from workshop participants, in the final workshops. A summary of input received and the changes sought in the amendment is below.
