Oregon E-Cycles

Beginning on Jan. 1, 2026, a modernized version of the Oregon E-Cycles will begin. This timeline was created to help interested parties prepare for some key dates occurring in the first two years of the program. This timeline is not exhaustive and should only be used as a high-level guide; for more details, all interested parties should review their full requirements in the <u>statute</u> and <u>administrative</u> rules.

Manufacturers register with DEQ and declare PRO for the 2027 program year	Oct. – Dec. 2026
2027 Program year begins	Jan. 1, 2027
Manufacturers submit 2026 sales data to DEQ	Jan. – March 2027
