Individual Verifier Requirements for Greenhouse Gas Reporting Program Requirements for General, Lead, and Sector-specific Verifier Approval



Individual verifier basic requirements:

Individual verifiers seeking approval to perform verification of emission data reports submitted to Oregon's Greenhouse Gas Reporting Program must apply for DEQ approval, take all required trainings and pass all required exams to provide verification services in Oregon. All applicants must be currently accredited through the California Air Resources Board (CARB) Mandatory GHG Reporting Program (MRR) or associated with a verification body that is accredited under ANSI National Accreditation Board (ANAB) Greenhouse Gas Validation/Verification Bodies Affiliation (VBB).

All general and lead verifiers applying for approval in Oregon must take the required training(s) and must pass the following exams:

- Course 1: Introduction to the Greenhouse Gas Reporting Program and Oregon Third-Party Verification
- Course 2: Stationary Sources General Information and Stationary Combustion Verification

Lead verifier requirements:

To receive approval as a lead verifier, the verifier must satisfy one of the following conditions:

- (a) The applicant is currently accredited as a lead verifier by CARB for the MRR program; or
- (b) The applicant is designated as a lead verifier by the ANAB-accredited VBB with which it is employed or affiliated.

Sector-Specific verifier requirements:

DEQ has developed sector-specific approval requirements corresponding to specific types of emissions data reports submitted to the reporting program. To receive approval to provide verification services for these report types, DEQ requires at least one member of a verification team is approved as an Oregon sector specialist in the corresponding sector.

Verifiers may seek sector-specific approval(s) from DEQ by demonstrating they have the relevant accreditations, education and experience and taking all of the Oregon required trainings and exams associated with the sector they wish to perform verification activities for, as listed in the Table 1. Verifiers may be approved in more than one sector. In addition to the trainings, verifiers seeking sector-specific approval must submit documentation to DEQ demonstrating at least two years of professional experience related to the sector in which they are seeking approval.

Table 1: Oregon greenhouse gas verifier training and accreditation requirements:

Applicants must take all required Oregon trainings, pass the required exams **and** have either the corresponding CARB MRR accreditation **or** the ANAB organizational level category experience to qualify for specific sector specialties.
