- EV Registration rebates. Customers can tell us where they are and what car they have for \$100 rebate Budget: \$4,000.
 - Level 2 rebates. Install a "connected" level 2 charger and receive a rebate of \$750 up to 50% of the total cost. Budget \$4,000
 - Business grant program offering \$18,000 towards the installation of level two charging. Budget \$72,000
 - School charging infrastructure at our 4 different high schools. Budget \$121,000
 - Electric car insider ride and drive event. Allowed customers to test out new EV's. Budget \$4,200.
- D) No incremental credit generation but we should have some this year. Looking to use that revenue for another ride and drive event in May and August 2022. Any additional funds will go to build out more infrastructure in our service territory.
