2022 CFP Annual Utility Report

The total revenue received in 2022 from the sale of base credits was \$164,786. These credits were received for residential vehicle charging in 2021. CRPUD does not participate in incremental credits.

The programs funded by the sale of these base credits and the amounts spent in 2022 are as follows:

- Installation of two DC Fast Chargers for a public EV charging station in downtown St. Helens, \$90,286.
- Purchase of two DC Fast Chargers at a cost of \$133,576, for a public EV charging station in Scappoose. The installation (and related costs) will occur in 2023.
- EV Charger rebates to electric customers in the PUD service area, \$6,250
- Yenter Group, EV Toolkit annual license, \$4,000
- EV Ride & Drive event expense, \$47
