## Annual Utility Report - 2022

Report submitted: March 29, 2023

McMinnville Water & Light realized total revenue of \$31,005 from the sale of Clean Fuel Credits in 2022. MW&L did not fund any programs with CFP revenue in 2022.

**Annual utility report requirement** –The language in [OAR 340-253-0640](#) is summarized here:

*All electric utilities that receive base or incremental credits must annually report the following items to DEQ no later than April 30th. Each utility must report the following information for the prior calendar year:*

*(a) Total revenue from the sale of base and incremental credits attributable to residential vehicle charging, if applicable; **Revenue of \$31,005 from the sale of Clean Fuel Credits in 2022***

*(b) For entities whose revenue or expenditures exceed \$250,000 in a given year, the percentages that result when dividing the utility's CFP-related administrative costs, including but not limited to submitting reports, selling credits, and to administer any programs that were funded by CFP revenue from the utility's sale of incremental credits, including but not limited to project management and development and management of contracts to operate such programs by the amount of revenue reported under subsection (a); **N/A***

*(c) A description of the programs that were funded by CFP revenue the utility received from its sale of base credits and the amount spent in each category; and **No programs were funded with CFP revenue in 2022***

*(d) A description of the programs that were funded by CFP revenue from incremental credits, the amount spent in each category, a description of the class of individuals or listing of organizations that benefited from the programs... **No programs were funded with CFP revenue in 2022***
