**2025 Annual Report**

Coos-Curry Electric Cooperative, Inc. (CCEC) is a member-owned, not-for-profit electric cooperative serving 14,028 members with 18,534 meters and 1,631 miles of distribution line. CCEC's service territory includes Coos County, Curry County, and a small portion of Douglas County on the southern Oregon coast.

This report summarizes Clean Fuels Program revenue received by CCEC during the 2025 calendar year and describes how those funds were used to support electric vehicle education, outreach, and member programs.

During calendar year 2025, CCEC received \$143,399 in revenue from the sale of base Clean Fuels Program credits attributable to residential electric vehicle charging.

CCEC's Clean Fuels Program revenue and expenditures did not exceed \$250,000 during calendar year 2025; therefore, reporting of administrative cost percentages is not applicable.

Clean Fuels Program revenue received in 2025 was used to support electric vehicle education, outreach, and program participation for CCEC members. CCEC provides electric vehicle education and outreach through its website, which includes information on available electric vehicle models, applicable credits and rebates, estimated cost savings, and public charging locations. EV education and website outreach \$3,200.

CCEC continues to offer an Off-Peak Home EV Charging Program, which provides participating members with a \$15 monthly bill credit for charging electric vehicles between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. During calendar year 2025, 106 members participated in this program. Off-Peak Home EV Charging bill credits: \$19,080.

In 2025, CCEC replaced a Kia Niro with a Chevy Equinox EV to support community outreach and electric vehicle education efforts. The vehicle is used for community outreach and to promote and demonstrate the benefits of electric vehicles. EV Vehicle cost (Chevy Equinox): \$24,185.
