## ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE

Douglas Electric Cooperative (DEC) delivers electricity to more than 11,000 meters across 2,500 square miles in western and northern Douglas County, with additional service territory in northeast and southeast Coos County and southern Lane County.

DEC is committed to supporting electric vehicle (EV) adoption and expanding access to EV charging infrastructure throughout the region.

### **EV Promotion and Infrastructure Highlights – 2025**

- Partnered with ChooseEV to provide members with detailed resources on the benefits and cost savings of EV ownership.
- Promoted a variety of EV models through targeted social media campaigns.
- Added a 2025 Tesla Model Y to complement our existing 2025 Ford F-150 Lightning. The F-150 has been transitioned into the fleet, while the Tesla is now used for member and staff demonstrations and test drives.
- Continued offering EV charger rebates to support both residential and commercial installations.

### **Clean Fuels Program Fund Utilization**

In 2025, DEC generated \$64,766 through the sale of Clean Fuels Program credits. These funds were allocated as follow:

- 2025 ChooseEV subscription: \$4,350
- Administrative and related expenses: \$12,250
- Marketing efforts: \$5,000
- Allocated fund for EV charger rebate program: \$5,000
- Purchase of 2026 Tesla Model Y: \$60,813

Future revenues generated through the Clean Fuels Program will be used to further expand DEC's electric vehicle fleet and support ongoing EV initiatives.
