On behalf of Forest Grove Light & Power (FGL&P), please find below our 2025 annual report for Clean Fuels Program (CFP) residential electricity credits, submitted in accordance with OAR 340-253-8010(11).

(a) Total Revenue from Residential Charging Credits

FGL&P received revenue from the sale of Clean Fuel Credits attributable to residential electric vehicle charging. Based on our 2025 transactions, the total revenue generated was approximately:

February 2025: 1,000 credits at \$50.00 for a total of \$50,000

August 2025: 1,000 credits at \$123.00 for a total of \$123,000

August 2025: 1,000 credits at \$130.00 for a total of \$130,000

Total 2025 Revenue: \$303,000

(b) Administrative Costs

As total revenue exceeded \$250,000, FGL&P tracks administrative costs associated with the Clean Fuels Program. These include program administration and reporting, credit monetization and transaction management, and incentive program development and implementation. Administrative costs remain minimal and primarily reflect staff time associated with reporting and program oversight.

(c) Programs Funded by Base Credits

FGL&P used CFP revenue to fund the Level-2 EV Charger Incentive Program. This program provides a \$500 rebate per installation, limited to one per location, and is available to residential, commercial, and industrial customers within the FGL&P service territory. The program allows for retroactive eligibility and requires installations to meet applicable code requirements. Funds were allocated directly to customer rebates to support EV adoption and charging infrastructure.

(d) Programs Funded by Incremental Credits

FGL&P has begun expanding its Clean Fuel Credit Incentive Program to provide broader benefits to customers.

Electric Bike (E-Bike) Incentive Program

FGL&P offers a \$200 incentive per e-bike, up to \$500 per household, for new Class 1, 2, and 3 e-bikes. This is a one-time per household incentive intended to provide lower-cost, zero-emission transportation options for customers.

Expanded Incentive Program Development

FGL&P is developing additional programs to broaden access to clean transportation and support future transportation electrification, benefiting customers across our service territory. These efforts are intended to improve access and customer support.

Program Overview

FGL&P's Clean Fuel Credit programs are designed to provide direct financial benefits to customers, support transportation electrification, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions within our service territory. Our goal is to use these Clean Fuel Credit revenues to support and expand clean transportation within our community and provide meaningful benefits to our customers. All funds used for these programs come from DEQ Clean Fuels Program revenues and do not impact utility rates. FGL&P will continue outreach efforts and provide program information in both English and Spanish.
