- (a) Revenue received from the sale of base and incremental Clean Fuel Credits was \$422,731.60.
- (b) Midstate Electric did not collect any CFP related administrative costs.
- (c) Funding from the sale of Clean Fuels credits was used for costs associated with the EV section of our website (\$4,800), EV charger service agreements (\$10,150), EV charger maintenance, the promotion of EV's, and Midstate's Public & home EV charger programs. The remaining funds are being held in reserve for future projects or programs.
- (d) Funds from the Clean Fuels Program funded our public Level 2 and fast charger programs, as well as our home charger program.
