



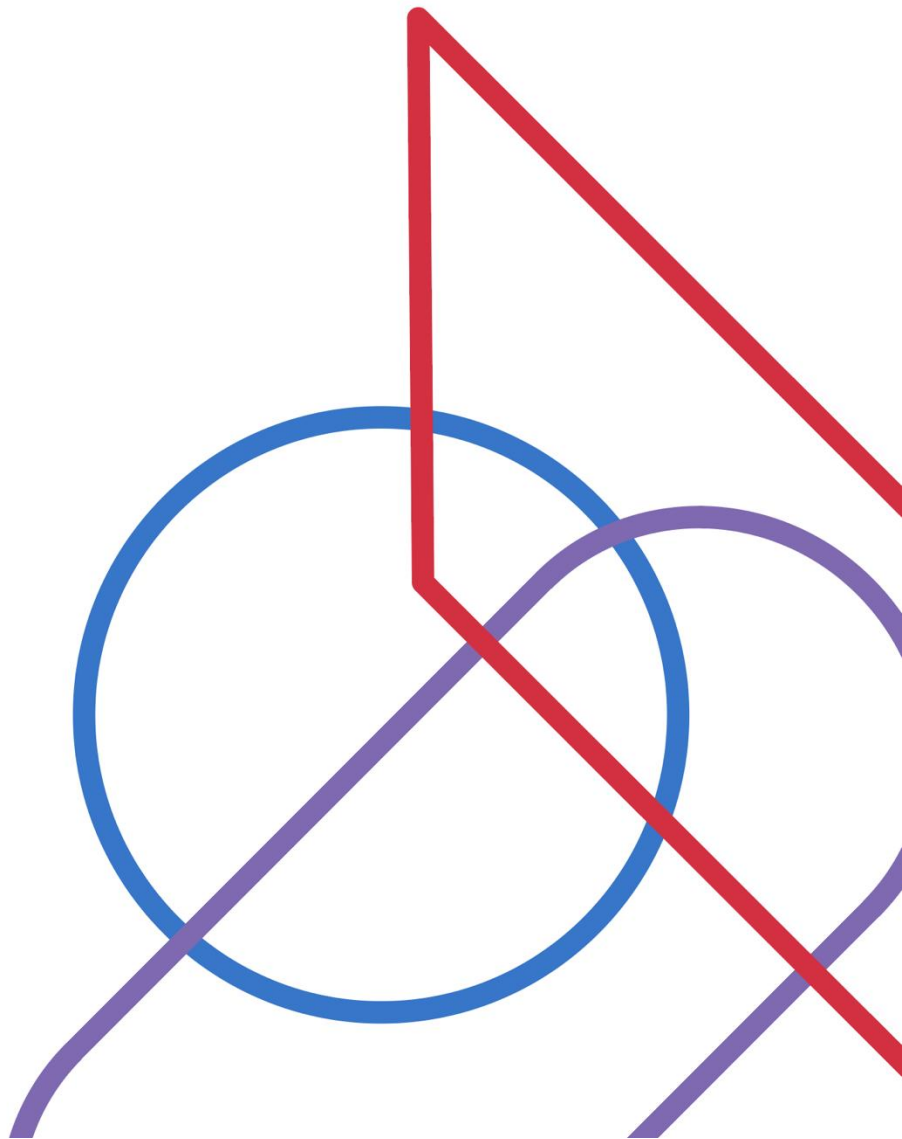
# Additional Services Proposal

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## I. Executive Summary

MED-Project USA ("MED-Project") has operated a Product Stewardship Plan for Covered Drugs from Households in the State of Oregon, under the Oregon Revised Statute 459A.200 to 459A.266 (the "Act"), as approved by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (the "Department") on May 20, 2021 ("Approved Plan"). MED-Project has served the residents of the State since 2021 and has submitted an additional services proposal each year as required under ORS 459A.218(3) where enough Drop-Off Sites have not been established (the "Variance Request"). MED-Project has demonstrated compliance with the Act, including the Variance Request requirements, and highlights a few notable examples as follows:

- Exceeding its annual Collection Goal for the fourth consecutive reporting period;
- Providing all Population Centers with either a Secure Repository or Mail-Back Distribution Location in 236 out of 241 Population Centers;
- Establishing a network of convenient and geographically distributed services supporting Population Centers not meeting ORS 459A.209(2)(i);
- Consistently engaging local health jurisdictions to obtain concurrence with the services offered with additional increased engagement in the past year resulting in almost all local health jurisdictions concurring with the services offered;
- Implementing a comprehensive outreach and education program that has resulted in an increase in public awareness in the Program including the additional services offered; and
- Continued outreach and implementation strategies for engagement of Historically Underserved Communities.

To achieve demonstrated compliance with the Act, MED-Project has reported expenditures of more than \$5,175,000 since the beginning of the Program through June 30, 2024.

## II. Overview

MED-Project submits this Additional Services Proposal to review the additional drug take-back services implemented between July 1, 2024, and June 30, 2025, and to propose to continue many of those additional drug take-back services. MED-Project submits this proposal for the Program year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026 ("2025-26 Program Year") pursuant to MED-Project's Product Stewardship Plan for Covered Drugs from Households (the "MED-Project Product Stewardship Plan") that was approved by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality ("Department") on May 20, 2021 (as modified on July 5, 2022, September 22, 2022, December 5, 2023, February 23, 2024, and January 3, 2025), the Oregon Drug Take-Back Law, ORS 459A.218(3), the Oregon Drug Take-Back Regulations, OAR 340-098-0350, the Recommended Format for a Variance Request from Required Drop-Off Sites per ORS 459A.218(3) received May 2, 2023, and the Department's approval of MED-Project USA's 2024-2025 Additional Services Proposal dated June 21, 2024. MED-Project submitted an Updated Product Stewardship Plan to the Department on May 19, 2025 and a revised Updated Product Stewardship Plan on October 14, 2025.

As of September 4, 2025, MED-Project is operating 191 Secure Repositories in 99 Population Centers. Table 1 provides more information about the number of Population Centers where MED-Project offers different types of collection services as the primary method for residents to dispose of Covered Drugs.

Appendix A lists the Secure Repositories and Mail-Back Distribution Locations MED-Project has established.

With over 90% of State residents living within a 20-minute drive of a Secure Repository, MED-Project continues to exceed its goal of having 90% of Covered Entities living within a 20-minute drive of a Drop-Off Site. When the network of Mail-Back Distribution

Locations is considered along with the availability of Drop-Off Sites, over 99% of State residents live within a 20-minute drive of a location providing a MED-Project disposal option. MED-Project also provides all State residents in all Population Centers the ability to request that Mail-Back Packages be shipped directly to their residence via the Website and Call Center.

Additionally, MED-Project supported four Collection Events during the 2024-2025 Reporting Period.

Based on the Program's successes in meeting full operation on July 1, 2021, fully implementing per the Implementation Timeline, and exceeding goals for the 2024-25 Program Year, MED-Project proposes to work to maintain current services offerings and add Local Agency Distribution Centers ("LADCs") barring brick and mortar pharmacy attrition and other factors outside of MED-Project's control. The following sections provide more details about MED-Project's proposed additional services.

## **A. Program Operator**

The Program Operator submitting this Additional Services Proposal is MED-Project USA, a Drug Take-Back Program Operator organized as a non-profit organization exempt from income tax under § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

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## **C. Program Year of Additional Services Proposal**

MED-Project submits this Additional Services Proposal for the 2025-26 Program Year.

## **D. Additional Services by Population Center**

MED-Project met or exceeded the number of Secure Repositories at Drop-Off Sites required under ORS 459A.209(2)(i) in 96 Population Centers. In the Population Center of Bend, MED-Project has two of the three required Secure Repositories, in the Population Centers of Springfield and Tigard, MED-Project has one of two required Secure Repositories. MED-Project notes that in the coming months ORS 459A.209(2)(i)

will be met in Bend, Springfield, and Tigard with Secure Repositories scheduled to be installed. Of State residents living in Population Centers, 81.2% live in a Population Center with at least the required number of Secure Repositories at Drop-Off Sites. When taking all Drop-Off Sites into account, over 90% of Covered Entities in the Population Center live within a 20-minute drive of a Drop-Off Site in that Population Center.

During the 2024-25 Program Year, MED-Project strived to add Mail-Back Distribution Locations to Population Centers that did not have the required number of Secure Repositories. MED-Project has established Mail-Back Distribution Locations in 140 Population Centers where the number of Secure Repositories required under ORS 459A.209(2)(i) has yet to be established. Of State residents living in Population Centers, over 99%, including those in Historically Underserved Communities, live in one of the 236 Population Centers where Secure Repositories or Mail-Back Distribution Locations have been established.

While we continue to work towards the service convenience requirements, MED-Project has done an assessment of the reasonably convenient and equitable access to residents and have determined that of the five Population Centers where MED-Project has yet to establish a Secure Repository or Mail-Back Distribution Location, three are within a 20-minute drive of a Secure Repository and the two remaining Population Centers, including Greenhorn and Lonerock, have a combined population of 28, and were sent materials advertising the Program and the availability of Mail-Back Packages. Of State residents living in Population Centers, 96% live within a 20-minute drive of a Secure Repository.

MED-Project also established nine Mail-Back Distribution Locations in unincorporated areas of the State outside of Population Centers. When taking all Secure Repositories and Mail-Back Distribution Locations into account, more than 99% of all State residents in a Population Center, including those in Historically Underserved Communities, live within a 20-minute drive of a Secure Repository or Mail-Back Distribution Location in that Population Center.

Appendix B lists how each Population Center without the required number of Secure Repositories at Drop-Off Sites was provided reasonably convenient and equitable access . Appendix C lists Mail-Back Distribution Locations MED-Project established by Population Center and County.

In addition to the Secure Repositories and Mail-Back Distribution Locations MED-Project established, Mail-Back Packages have been available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year to all Covered Entities through the Website and Call Center since July 1, 2021. Education and outreach efforts to promote the Program, including the availability of Mail-Back Packages, are described in the MED-Project Product Stewardship Plan.

MED-Project worked with local law enforcement to support four Collection Events, one being in a Population Center not served by a Drop-Off Site. Appendix D provides a list of Collection Events held, the date the Collection Events were held, the county where the Collection Events were held, local law enforcement that provided oversight, local solid waste management agencies consulted, and pounds collected. MED-Project has historically supported Collection Events each year and will seek out opportunities to support Collection Events, including when requested by a local health jurisdiction or a law enforcement agency, in a county where MED-Project was unable to establish the Secure Repositories required under ORS 459A.209(2)(i) and where MED-Project is able to secure local law enforcement participation to schedule a Collection Event in the county or at a central gathering location for the residents of the county.

If MED-Project schedules any Collection Events during the 2025-26 Program Year, MED-Project will provide the Department the following information at least 60 days prior to the proposed date for the Collection Event or as soon as practicable, and no less than 15 days prior to the date of a scheduled Collection Event:

- Date of scheduled event.
- Contact information of local solid waste management officials with which program operator will coordinate event.
- Contact information of local law enforcement that will oversee the event.
- Vendor to be used at the event.

During the 2025-26 Program Year, MED-Project proposes to rely on a blend of Mail-Back Distribution Locations within Population Centers, LADCs or access to a Secure Repository or Mail-Back Distribution Location within a 20-minute drive of a Population Center in areas where the number of Secure Repositories required under ORS 459A.209(2)(i) have not been established. MED-Project may account for Secure Repositories in overlapping Population Centers when evaluating where to provide additional services. MED-Project anticipates a potential decrease in the number of available authorized collectors due to a number of factors including brick-and-mortar pharmacy closures at a potentially accelerated rate over the coming years and financial pressures on pharmacy retailers leading to constraints on materials, staffing, and space.



The changing pharmacy landscape aligns with trends in consumer behavior. Consumers are increasingly relying on online and mail-order pharmacies that are providing central fill, auto-fill, and online delivery services, just as they are increasingly relying on online purchases and at-home deliveries for many consumer products that they used to purchase in-person at brick-and-mortar stores. Residents are also increasingly familiar with and served by pharmacy-related Mail-Back Services. To adjust to the changing pharmacy landscape, MED-Project will work with pharmacies that offer online services through non-resident licensed pharmacies and will provide outreach to support such non-resident pharmacy location awareness and access to program materials including information around safe disposal and how Covered Entities can access Program services. Annually, MED-Project will identify licensed non-resident pharmacies through the Oregon State Board of Pharmacy, notify licensed non-resident pharmacies, and monitor their participation in the Program. As of September 2025, the Oregon Board of Pharmacy lists over 800 licensed non-resident pharmacies.

MED-Project will strive to meet the service convenience requirements in ORS 459A.209(2)(i). If MED-Project is unable to establish Drop-Off Sites in any Population Centers that are impacted by closures, MED-Project will strive to establish additional Mail-Back Distribution Locations and LADCs, may schedule Collection Events (where law enforcement agencies are willing to oversee the Collection Event), and may offer direct mailings as necessary to supplement Drop-Off Sites.

## **E. Drop-Off Sites Not Established or Maintained**

MED-Project was not able to establish the number of Secure Repositories at Drop-Off Sites required under ORS 459A.209(2)(i) in 145 Population Centers, and of those 145 Population Centers, 140 Population Centers were serviced by Mail-Back Distribution Locations. See Section II.D. for a complete review of the proposed additional services covering all Population Centers.

## **F. Factors**

The following sections provide the information requested in the Recommended Format for a Variance Request from Required Drop-Off Sites per ORS 459A.218(3) and the Department's approval of MED-Project USA's 2024-2025 Additional Services Proposal.

### **1. Good Faith Efforts to Enter into Agreements with Potential Authorized Collectors**

As required by ORS 459A.215, MED-Project began contacting Potential Authorized Collectors before submitting the Plan. MED-Project contacted Potential Authorized Collectors in the State through a direct mail campaign. Following the direct mail campaign, MED-Project contacted many of those Potential Authorized Collectors at the headquarters and individual site level by phone, email, or in-person site visits.

MED-Project solicited Potential Authorized Collectors already hosting a Secure Repository, as identified in the Department's Guide for Oregon Drug Take-Back Programs, and Potential Authorized Collectors that did not already host a Secure Repository.

MED-Project solicited Potential Authorized Collectors in Population Centers where MED-Project was unable to establish the Secure Repositories required under ORS 459A.209(2)(i) on an annual basis through an opportunity to participate letter. This outreach was done in February of 2024 and 2025. [Appendix E](#) provides a list of Potential Authorized Collectors MED-Project contacted in 2025 in Population Centers where MED-Project was unable to establish the Secure Repositories required under ORS 459A.209(2)(i).

MED-Project begins good faith negotiations with all interested Potential Authorized Collectors once the Potential Authorized Collector has expressed interest in writing in participating in the Program. MED-Project seeks to enter into agreements with any eligible Potential Authorized Collector willing to participate and host a Secure Repository.

## **2. Conditions for Participation**

[Appendix E](#) provides the reason, if available, each non-participating Potential Authorized Collector in Population Centers where MED-Project was unable to establish the Secure Repositories required under ORS 459A.209(2)(i) was not interested in participating in the Program or is not yet participating in the Program. The following are types of scenarios in which MED-Project may not have entered into an agreement with a Potential Authorized Collector:

- The Potential Authorized Collector did not respond to MED-Project's outreach.
- The Potential Authorized Collector was not interested in participating in the Program.
- The Potential Authorized Collector was already participating as a Drop-Off Site in another stewardship program or receiving a grant to host a secure repository.
- The Potential Authorized Collector responded to MED-Project and is in discussions regarding the agreement or is determining the participation of sites once the agreement is executed.

## **3. Reasonably Convenient and Equitable Access**

A high level of awareness of the program services has been obtained. For example, during the 2024-2025 program year, MED-Project conducted the second biennial survey of residents and health care providers. Among Oregon residents, 74% were aware of pharmacy drop-boxes, 63% were aware of local take-back events, and 60% were aware of police station drop boxes. Of respondents to MED-Project's biennial survey who indicated they used collection services in Oregon, 84% responded that they had used drop-off locations, 21% responded that they had attended take-back events, and 15%

responded that they had used mail-back services. Of those using the services, 91% found them easy to use and 82% found them convenient.

On February 3, 2025, MED-Project notified 118 Potential Authorized Collectors in Population Centers where MED-Project was unable to establish the Secure Repositories required under ORS 459A.209(2)(i) of the opportunity to participate in the Program. Based on analysis of US Census data, nearly all Potential Authorized Collectors in the State are in a Population Center that contains Historically Underserved Communities.

During the first year of Program operation following July 1, 2021, MED-Project added a third-party translation tool to the Website, providing translations into over 100 languages. This translation tool continues to provide opportunities for speakers of many different languages to utilize the Program. As additional languages are added to the third-party translation tool, the MED-Project Website will also be available in those languages. Additionally, MED-Project added an accessibility tool to the MED-Project Website to facilitate engagement by individuals with a disability. As of May 1, 2025, the MED-Project Website had received 34,568 website views since it was launched on July 1, 2021.

Since July 1, 2021, MED-Project's media outreach has generated over 45 million impressions, including campaigns specifically targeted towards Historically Underserved Communities. In addition, MED-Project conducted targeted social media outreach to promote Collection Events in Clackamas County and Crook County as follows:

July 16, 2024: Facebook, X and Instagram posts on Keizer Elks Lodge's July 20, 2024 Collection Event.

April 21, 2025: Facebook, X and Instagram posts on Molalla Police Department's April 25 & 26, 2025 Collection Event.

April 29, 2025: Facebook, X and Instagram posts on Prineville Police Department's May 3, 2025 Collection Event.

May 6, 2025: Facebook, X and Instagram posts on Gladstone Police Department's May 10, 2025 Collection Event.

MED-Project also provided promotional materials to participating law enforcement agencies and conducted media outreach to promote Collection Events. Press alerts were sent to local and regional media outlets and posted to the MED-Project Website. The Keizer Elks Lodges event was featured in the July 28, 2024, edition of the *Salem Reporter*. The Prineville Police Department's event was featured in the April 29, 2025, edition of *The Bulletin*. These Collection Events, along with the related media outreach, reached Population Centers in counties with Historically Underserved Communities.

During the 2025-26 Program Year, MED-Project will continue statewide outreach efforts to achieve broader public awareness, with a focus on engaging diverse audiences, including Historically Underserved Communities.

**a. Collection Relative to Drop-Off Sites**

Since initiating services in Oregon, MED-Project has destroyed over 250,000 pounds of Covered Drugs collected through Secure Repositories, over 3,500 pounds of Covered Drugs collected through Mail-Back Services, and over 700 pounds of Covered Drugs collected at Collection Events. MED-Project's public service announcements advertise the availability of Mail-Back Packages at Mail-Back Distribution Locations to residents aged 18 and over.

MED-Project will continue to prioritize establishing and sustaining Secure Repositories to meet the requirements of ORS 459A.209(2)(i) where Potential Authorized Collectors are available, however MED-Project expects that Mail-Back Services and LADCs will be an important part of the Program. Mail-Back Distribution Locations and LADCs will provide residents opportunities to pick up Mail-Back Packages and Standard Mail-Back Packages, respectively at locations that are convenient to them in their communities. Additionally, all residents can order Mail-Back Packages 24 hours a day, 365 days per year, through the Website or Call Center, and it is notable that residents in rural areas in Oregon, Historically Underserved Communities, or residents who are homebound may find these to be especially important for convenient access.

**b. How Supplemental Services Will Achieve Collection Goals**

Since initiating services in Oregon, MED-Project has collected over 255,000 pounds of Covered Drugs. Additionally, MED-Project collection weight goals are approximately 125% of the Potential SCR Drop-Off Site Collection Weight because the current number of Drop-Off Sites exceed the required Drop-Off Sites in some Population Centers as specified in ORS 459A.209(2)(i) offering Covered Entities additional collection services. As the current number of Drop-Off Sites exceeds the minimum number required in many of the Population Centers, MED-Project's collection weight goal more than accounts for the Population Centers Not Served By Drop-Off Sites. MED-Project has consistently exceeded targets for activating Secure Repositories. Additionally, as reported in MED-Project's 2023-2024 Annual Report, MED-Project exceeded its July 1, 2023, collection goal of 26,000 pounds. MED-Project's collection weights since July 1, 2023, show that collection totals have remained consistent, and MED-Project anticipates meeting the annual collection goal in the Updated Plan submitted on October 14, 2025.

Upon approval of the Updated Plan, MED-Project will supply participating LADCs with as many Standard Mail-Back Packages as needed to support the volume of unwanted or expired Covered Drugs a resident is seeking to dispose of, as described in the Update Plan. Additionally, MED-Project will provide participating LADCs with Standard Mail-Back Packages for community events, as requested by the participating LADC.

MED-Project anticipates that resident utilization behavior of LADCs will result in increased collection for Population Centers that do not meet SCR.

**c. Measuring Reasonably Convenient and Equitable Access**

MED-Project established 206 Mail-Back Distribution Locations in 178 Population Centers with an additional nine Mail-Back Distribution Locations in the unincorporated areas of the State. In total, there are 215 Mail-Back Distribution Locations in 35 Oregon counties. MED-Project signed agreements with each of these Mail-Back Distribution Locations. In these agreements, the locations committed to provide Mail-Back Packages to residents at no cost, reorder Mail-Back Packages as necessary to maintain inventory, and distribute materials providing additional information about the Program, including how to order Mail-Back Packages at any time through the Website and Call Center.

Mail-Back Distribution Locations are located at different types of facilities, including libraries, town halls, community centers, and fire departments. The diversity of locations where Mail-Back Distribution Locations are located provides options for residents to obtain Mail-Back Packages at the type of facility that is most convenient to them.

The Department requested MED-Project report on the effectiveness of Mail-Back Distribution Locations in providing convenience, (See 2024 Variance Request Approval letter from Sanne Stienstra, Program Manager Materials Management Oregon Department of Environmental Quality, to Dr. Victoria Travis, National Program Director MED-Project USA dated June 21, 2024). In response to the Department's request, MED-Project is reporting that the effectiveness of Mail-Back Distribution Locations is increasing year over year with a 67% increase in total weight collected through Mail-Back Services. For perspective, this Mail-Back Services collection weight is equivalent to the cumulative collection weight of approximately 20% of MED-Project's Secure Repositories for the same reporting period. Mail-Back Distribution Locations continue to provide an important role in the overall delivery of convenient take-back services to Oregonians as discussed in Section II.D. Additionally, MED-Project has continued to promote Mail-Back Services through the outreach and education campaigns, including a public service announcement, contributing to an increase in resident awareness. For example, the 2024 resident awareness survey found that 74% of residents were aware of drug take-back services, a substantial increase from 40% awareness reported in the 2022 survey, with 40% of residents reporting being aware of the mail-back program.

MED-Project has designed its outreach and education program to clearly communicate how to obtain and use mail-back packages, emphasizing the convenience of at-home disposal, the safety of the disposal method, and that the service is provided at no cost to residents.

Upon approval of the Updated Plan, MED-Project will implement services per the implementation timeline as described in the Updated Plan.

During the 2025-26 Program Year, MED-Project proposes to continue promoting Mail-Back Distribution Locations and additional services as described in the Updated Plan through public service announcements and outreach about the Program to reach a total of 75% or more of Covered Entities who are residents aged 18 and over.

During the 2025-26 Program Year, MED-Project proposes to distribute, if requested, Standard Mail-Back Package displays to participating Mail-Back Distribution Locations.

Upon approval of the Updated Plan, MED-Project proposes to distribute, Standard Mail-Back Packages to participating LADCs, as described in the Updated Plan.

During the 2024-25 Program Year, MED-Project sent materials advertising the Program and the availability of Mail-Back Packages to residential addresses in ZIP codes that cover Granite, Greenhorn, and Lonerock. An example of the mailing is provided in Appendix F.

During the 2025-26 Program Year, MED-Project proposes to promote the Program to Barlow, Greenhorn, Lonerock, Prescott, and Rivergrove residents by sending materials advertising the Program and the availability of Mail-Back Packages to residential addresses in ZIP codes that cover these Population Centers.

During the 2024-25 Program Year, MED-Project met with the CEO of the Oregon Hospice and Palliative Care Association to discuss the needs of hospice facilities in the State. MED-Project discussed awareness of the Drug Take-Back Program and how to access Mail-Back Packages and resources available to hospice sites within the State. MED-Project provided the Oregon Hospice and Palliative Care Association with educational materials advertising the Mail-Back Distribution Location program that can be provided to hospice facilities throughout the State. Hospice facilities can register to become a Mail-Back Distribution Location and be provided Mail-Back Packages that can be handed out to their patients, upon request.

During the 2025-26 Program Year, MED-Project proposes to continue efforts to provide hospice facilities with information to raise awareness of the Drug-Take-Back Program and access to materials and Mail-Back Services.

During the 2024-25 Program Year, MED-Project met with Oregon's Kitchen Table to discuss the Drug Take-Back Program and how to best engage the Historically Underserved Communities with the services that are available to those communities.

During the 2025-26 Program Year, MED-Project will work directly with Oregon's Kitchen Table to design and facilitate a public engagement process for residents across Oregon including Historically Underserved Communities within the State. The public engagement process will continue efforts to provide information to raise awareness



about the Drug Take-Back Program and continued engagement with the Historically Underserved Communities within the State.

During the 2024-25 Program Year, MED-Project started a General Delivery service of Mail-Back Packages when a permanent address is not available to ensure the houseless residents of Oregon have the availability to order Mail-Back Packages. The General Delivery service will deliver the Mail-Back Package to the nearest U.S. Post Office that is participating as a General Delivery site.

Per the Updated Plan, upon Plan approval, MED-Project will notify LADCs in the State of the opportunity to participate in the Program and will document the reasons that are beyond MED-Project's control if a LADC is not participating in the Program.

Per the Updated Plan, upon Plan approval, MED-Project will establish LADCs. MED-Project believes that having a participating LADC in areas that cannot establish the Drop-Off Sites needed to meet the SCR would be equivalent to Drop-Off Sites in that area as residents already readily utilize these centralized household hazardous waste collection sites for a variety of unwanted or expired household hazardous materials.

Per the Updated Plan, upon Plan approval, MED-Project will supply participating LADCs with as many Standard Mail-Back Packages as needed to support the volume of unwanted or expired Covered Drugs a resident is seeking to dispose of. Additionally, MED-Project will provide participating LADCs with Standard Mail-Back Packages for community events, as requested by the participating LADC.

MED-Project will annually report on activity and participation status of LADCs in the Program to the Department.

#### **d. Efforts to Obtain Concurrence**

To obtain concurrence for proposed additional services and Collection Events from appropriate local governments in Population Centers where MED-Project was unable to establish the Secure Repositories required under ORS 459A.209(2)(i), MED-Project performed the following:

- To further increase engagement with the local health jurisdictions, MED-Project visited each of the local health jurisdictions in person to socialize information about MED-Project and the Drug Take-Back Program and to identify opportunities to establish Mail-Back Distribution Locations or schedule Collection Events.
- Provided a survey to obtain concurrence with proposed methods for providing Mail-Back Distribution Locations or information about ordering Mail-Back Packages in the affected Population Centers and to obtain feedback on MED-Project's proposed outreach to Historically Underserved Communities. Several of the local governments identified themselves as representing Historically Underserved Communities.

- Contacted local health jurisdictions individually through email and by phone to follow up on some of the data received from the survey.

Note that LADCs were not included in this outreach as they have not yet been approved in MED-Project's Updated Plan.

Appendix G provides additional information on the survey responses received and other efforts to obtain concurrence from local governments during the 2024-2025 Program Year. As of the submission of this Additional Services Proposal, MED-Project attempted to visit 36 local health jurisdictions in person. MED-Project was unable to visit three local health jurisdictions (Wallowa County, Coos County, Clatsop County) due to the local health jurisdiction being closed or having very limited hours for visits. MED-Project was able to successfully visit 33 local health jurisdictions in person with only seven local health jurisdictions declining to participate in the survey. MED-Project received 26 responses to MED-Project's survey about additional services. Nineteen local governments indicated that they do concur with the services proposed. Seven local governments indicated that they "maybe" do concur with the services proposed and included additional suggestions around Drop-Off Sites, Mail-Back Distribution Locations, Collection Events, and outreach. There was no local government that responded that they do not concur. MED-Project followed up with all the local health jurisdictions that responded with a "maybe" response. MED-Project sent an opportunity to participate to Potential Authorized Collectors in all the local health jurisdictions. Additionally, all the local health jurisdictions that completed the survey were given access to the local health jurisdiction toolkit that consists of outreach and education materials to further increase public awareness.

**e. Commitment to Solicit Potential Authorized Collectors for affected Population Centers**

MED-Project will continue to solicit Potential Authorized Collectors in Population Centers where MED-Project has not established the Secure Repositories required under ORS 459A.209(2)(i). MED-Project will annually solicit available Potential Authorized Collectors who are not participating in a State approved plan in accordance with Plan § V.A.2.j. Additionally, MED-Project will annually solicit Potential Authorized Collectors in areas that are not meeting the requirements of ORS 459A.209(2)(i) via phone or in-person and will document reasons beyond MED-Project's control as to why a Potential Authorized Collector is not participating in the Program.

**G. Compliance with Applicable Law**

MED-Project will establish and conduct the additional services proposed in this Additional Services Proposal in accordance with all applicable laws and MED-Project's Product Stewardship Plan.

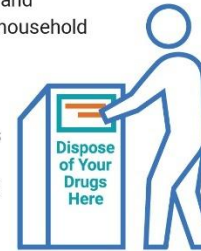
