# 2026 Grant Cycle Update: Informational Webinars for the 2026 RRR Grant Program

Oregon DEQ's Materials Management Program is excited to announce free webinars to help interested applicants prepare for the 2026 cycle of the Reduce, Reuse, Reimagine Grant Program.

The 2026 grant cycle focuses on reducing exposure to toxic substances in building materials. These webinars are designed to give applicants a clear understanding of the funding area, highlight project opportunities, and connect with DEQ staff about project eligibility.

- Time to connect directly with DEQ staff about project eligibility


These sessions are designed to help interested applicants gain clarity before the application period opens.
