

Reduce, Reuse, Reimagine Grant Program: Pre-Application Opening Date and Information Session Dates

Pre-Application opens March 23, 2026

The application will open Monday, March 23, 2026. The application will close at 4 p.m. on April 30, 2026. Applications will not be accepted after the deadline.

Submitting pre-applications through WebGrants

DEQ will be accepting grant pre-applications through the online system, WebGrants. [Click here to create your WebGrants account](#). It may take 1-3 days to receive an email with your username and password.

WebGrants works best on a laptop or desktop computer. You may encounter problems using a mobile phone or tablet.

Pre-application accessibility

At this time, WebGrants is only available in English. Application materials in Cantonese, German, Mandarin, Russian, Spanish, and Vietnamese will be available on our website when the pre-application opens on March 23, 2026. Please email DEQ at RRRGrants@deq.oregon.gov with any additional language requests by March 9, 2026. If you do not have stable internet access or have other needs or access barriers, please contact us by March 9, 2026 and we will provide assistance.

Information sessions and office hours

DEQ will host information sessions for those interested in applying for the 2026 grant cycle which will focus on the Built Environment. Many building materials such as carpets, paint, furniture, insulation, and contract textiles contain toxic chemicals that are harmful to people and to the environment. Selected projects will demonstrate an effort to reduce exposure to these toxic chemicals. Information Sessions will cover funding areas, project eligibility, application guidance, and timelines. There will also be time allotted for questions and answers, and to connect with DEQ staff to discuss project concepts.

All sessions will be held virtually through Zoom (registration required) and will be recorded and posted to the DEQ website. For accessibility needs or translation services, contact RRRGrants@deq.oregon.gov at least five days in advance.
