## Estimates of Paint Collection Volumes 2018 - 2019

Year	Total (gallons)	% Retail	% Solid Waste Infrastructure	% PaintCare Collection Events	% Large Volume User/Pick-up
2018	795,786	50.4	46.4	0.6	2.7
2019	767,088	51.6	43.4	0.6	4.4

# 2020 Oregon DEQ Paint Product Stewardship Stakeholder Meeting

## 2019 Annual Collections

- 1) 4% decline in collection volume from 2018
  - Percent of paint collection from retail and solid waste infrastructure remained about the same as in 2018
    - 50.4% from retail and 46.4% from solid waste infrastructure for 2019
- 2) Continued development of program metrics
- 3) Paint-to-Cement was a new category in 2018, but none sent in 2019
  - Instead most was processed as paint-to-paint

# 2020 Oregon DEQ Paint Product Stewardship Stakeholder Meeting

## Highlights of Wasteshed Estimates of Paint Collection Volumes 2019

- Metro region continues to account for over 50% of the annual paint collections
  - The next three highest were Deschutes, Marion, and Lane (ranging from 8 to 7%)
  - Two counties saw no collections – Gilliam and Wheeler
- Lake now serviced by a collection site instead of PaintCare events
  - Now Milton-Freewater is the only wasteshed serviced exclusively by PaintCare events
  - Three other counties also did not have PaintCare collection events this year – Baker, Clatsop, and Coos
