

## Solid Waste Disposal Fees

### 2019 per ton changes

#### 2015 Senate Bills 245 and 263

Legislation passed in 2015 established new responsibilities for DEQ's Materials Management Program, and authorized increases in solid waste disposal fees to fund this new work and to address sharp declines in disposal tonnage revenue. In February 2016, the Environmental Quality Commission adopted rules increasing these disposal fees. The fee increases affected landfills and other "final disposal" facilities including energy recovery facilities, solid waste treatment facilities, and conversion technology facilities. They did not affect composters, transfer stations, or material recovery facilities. The fee schedule can be found in [OAR 340 Division 97](#).

#### Fee increase schedule

The fee increases occurred in a two stage schedule. In April 2016, the first stage increased the tipping fee from \$.81 per ton to \$1.11 per ton and increased the permit fee from \$0.30 per ton to \$0.58 per ton. The second stage increased the tipping fee to \$1.18 per ton effective April 1, 2019 (payable to DEQ in July 2019).
