Notice of Civil Penalty Assessment and Order

Case No. WQ/SW-WR-2022-516

This letter is to inform you that the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has issued you a civil penalty of \$8,750 for failing to perform all of the required grab sample monitoring during the 2020-2021 monitoring year as required under the NPDES 1200-Z Industrial Stormwater General Permit. During that monitoring year, Valley Milling & Lumber, LLC, was the registrant for coverage under the 1200-Z permit at the facility located at 90737 Link Road in Eugene.

DEQ issued this penalty because monitoring is an important condition of the Permit and this is a repeat violation. In 2019, DEQ issued you a civil penalty in an Expedited Enforcement Offer (EEO) for failing to conduct monitoring required by the permit in the 2017-2018 monitoring year.

Monitoring may reveal the presence of harmful levels of pollutants that pose a threat to waters of the state. In addition, monitoring allows permittees and DEQ to gauge the effectiveness of stormwater controls and best management practices at reducing levels of pollutants in discharges.

DEQ appreciates your efforts to return to compliance for the 2021-2022 monitoring year. DEQ considered these efforts when determining the amount of civil penalty.

You may pay the civil penalty as follows:

If you wish to appeal this matter, DEQ must receive a request for a hearing within 20 calendar days from your receipt of this letter. The hearing request must be in writing. Send your request to DEQ Office of Compliance and Enforcement:

Once DEQ receives your request, we will arrange to meet with you to discuss this matter. If DEQ does not receive a timely written hearing request, the penalty will become due.

The attached Notice further details DEQ's reasons for issuing the penalty and provides further instructions for appealing the penalty. <u>Please review and refer to it when discussing this case with DEQ</u>.

DEQ may allow you to resolve part of your penalty through the completion of a Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP). SEPs are environmental improvement projects that you sponsor instead of paying a portion of your penalty. 6	I. AUTHORITY				
7	The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) issues this Notice of Civil Penalty Assessment				
8	and Order (Notice) pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 468.100, ORS 468.126 through 468.140,				
9	ORS Chapter 183, ORS Chapter 468B, and Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 340, Divisions				
10	011, 012, and 045.				
11	II. FINDINGS OF FACT				
12	1. Respondent is registered under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System				
13	1200-Z Permit (the Permit) for the facility located at 90737 Link Road in Eugene, Oregon (the				
14	Facility).				
15	2. Schedule B, Condition 2.a.i and f, and Table 5 of the Permit require permit registrants to				
16	monitor for statewide benchmarks four times per monitoring year (July 1 through June 30).				
17	3. Respondent did not conduct one of the required monitoring events for the monitoring				
18	year 2020-2021.				
19	III. CONCLUSIONS				
20	Respondent has violated ORS 468B.025(2) and Schedule B, Condition 2 of the Permit by				
21	failing to perform one of the required instances of grab sample monitoring, at Outfall 001 and 002, during				
22	the 2020-2021 monitoring year. These are Class I violations pursuant to OAR 340-012-0055(1)(o). DEQ				
23	hereby assesses a \$8,750 civil penalty for these violations.				
24	IV. ORDER TO PAY CIVIL PENALTY				
25	Based upon the foregoing FINDINGS OF FACTS AND CONCLUSIONS, Respondent is				
26	hereby ORDERED TO:

Pay a total civil penalty of \$8,750. The determination of the civil penalty is in the attached Exhibit and is incorporated as part of this Notice.

V. NOTICE OF RIGHT TO REQUEST A CONTESTED CASE HEARING

You have a right to a contested case hearing on this Notice, if you request one in writing. DEQ must receive your request for hearing within 20 calendar days from the date you receive this Notice. If you have any affirmative defenses or wish to dispute any allegations of fact in this Notice or attached exhibits, you must do so in your request for hearing, as factual matters not denied will be considered admitted, and failure to raise a defense will be a waiver of the defense. (See OAR 340-011-0530 for further information about requests for hearing.) You must send your request to: DEQ, Office of Compliance and Enforcement, 700 NE Multnomah Street, Suite 600, Portland, Oregon 97232, fax it to 503-229-5100 or email it to DEQappeals@deq.state.or.us. An administrative law judge employed by the Office of Administrative Hearings will conduct the hearing, according to ORS Chapter 183, OAR Chapter 340, Division 011 and OAR 137-003-0501 to 0700. You have a right to be represented by an attorney at the hearing, however you are not required to be. If you are an individual, you may represent yourself. If you are a corporation, partnership, limited liability company, unincorporated association, trust or government body, you must be represented by an attorney or a duly authorized representative, as set forth in OAR 137-003-0555.

FINDINGS AND DETERMINATION OF RESPONDENT'S CIVIL PENALTY PURSUANT TO OREGON ADMINISTRATIVE RULE (OAR) 340-012-0045

VIOLATION:

Failing to perform all the required monitoring of statewide

benchmark pollutants in the 2020-2021 monitoring year, in violation of Schedule B, Condition 2 and Table 5 of the Permit and ORS

468B.025(2).

CLASSIFICATION:

These are Class I violations pursuant to OAR 340-012-0055(1)(o).

MAGNITUDE:

The magnitude of the violation is moderate pursuant to OAR 340-012-0130(1), as there is no selected magnitude specified in OAR 340-012-0135 applicable to this violation, and the information reasonably available to DEQ does not indicate a minor or major

magnitude.

CIVIL PENALTY FORMULA:

The formula for determining the amount of penalty of each violation is: $BP + [(0.1 \times BP) \times (P + H + O + M + C)] + EB$

- "BP" is the base penalty, which is \$4,000 for a Class I, moderate magnitude violation in the matrix listed in OAR 340-012-0140(3)(b)(A)(ii) and applicable pursuant to OAR 340-012-0140(3)(a)(E)(iii) because Respondent has coverage under an NPDES General Permit.
- "P" is whether Respondent has any prior significant actions, as defined in OAR 340-012-0030(19), in the same media as the violation at issue that occurred at a facility owned or operated by the same Respondent, and receives a value of 2 according to OAR 340-012-0145(2)(a)(C). Respondent accepted Expedited Enforcement Offer (EEO) Number WQ/SW-WR-2019-032, issued June 27, 2019, which cited Respondent for one Class I violation.
- "H" is Respondent's history of correcting prior significant actions, and receives a value of 0 according to OAR 340-012-0145(3)(c) because there is insufficient information on which to base a finding under paragraphs (3)(a) or (b).
- "O" is whether the violation was repeated or ongoing, and receives a value of 2 according to OAR 340-012-0145(4)(b) because there were more than one but less than seven occurrences of the violation. Each missed sampling event at each outfall is a separate occurrence of the violation. The Permit requires Respondent to monitor stormwater discharges four times per monitoring year at each of two outfalls, and Respondent only conducted three of the required four samples at each outfall. Therefore, there were two occurrences of the violation.
- "M" is the mental state of the Respondent, and receives a value of 8 according to OAR 340-012-0145(5)(d), because Respondent intentionally failed to act, with actual knowledge of the requirement. Respondent applied for coverage under the Permit and has a copy of the

Permit, which expressly requires Respondent to perform monitoring according to the frequency prescribed in the Permit. Additionally, Respondent has been cited and penalized for violating the Permit's monitoring requirements in a previous Expedited Enforcement Offer, issued June 27, 2019.

- "C" is Respondent's efforts to correct or mitigate the violation, and receives a value of -1 according to OAR 340-012-0145(6)(e) because Respondent made reasonable efforts to ensure the violation would not be repeated. Respondent conducted required monitoring for the 2021-2022 monitoring year.
- "EB" is the approximate dollar value of the benefit gained and the costs avoided or delayed as a result of the Respondent's noncompliance. It is designed to "level the playing field" by taking away any economic advantage the entity gained and to deter potential violators from deciding it is cheaper to violate and pay the penalty than to pay the costs of compliance. In this case, "EB" receives a value of \$350. This is the amount Respondent gained by avoiding spending \$589 to conduct required stormwater monitoring on or before June 30, 2021. This "EB" was calculated pursuant to OAR 340-012-0150(1) using the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's BEN computer model.

<u>PENALTY CALCULATION</u>: Penalty = $BP + [(0.1 \times BP) \times (P + H + O + M + C)] + EB$

- $= \$4,000 + [(0.1 \times \$4,000) \times (2 + 0 + 2 + 8 + (-1))] + \350
- $= $4,000 + ($400 \times 11) + 350
- = \$4,000 + \$4,400 + \$350
- =\$8,750
