No. WQ-SW-NWR-2022-526

On July 10, 2023, you received a Notice of Civil Penalty Assessment and Order. Since you did not request a contested case hearing within the time allowed, the Order became final by operation of law. The Order requires you to pay \$17,735 civil penalty and to implement corrective actions to come into compliance with your 1200-Z permit. Please send the documentation, prior to August 31, to: Mike Kennedy, 700 NE Multnomah St Suite 600, Portland, OR 97232. If you fail to comply, DEQ may take further legal actions to enforce those requirements, including additional civil penalties.

You may appeal the Order to the Oregon Court of Appeals as provided in ORS 183.482, but please note that an appeal will not stay any of the compliance requirements unless you request a stay pursuant to ORS 183.482(3), and a stay is granted.

If you do not file an appeal to the Oregon Court of Appeals within 60 days of the date of service of the Order, by September 8, the civil penalty becomes due and payable 10 days after that date on September 18. If the civil penalty remains unpaid after that time, liens may be filed against any property you own. You will not be able to clear title of your property in a sale without paying the penalty plus interest. DEQ will also pursue collection of the penalty through other legal means.

If you do not intend to appeal, please promptly pay the \$17,735 penalty as follows:

Pay online with e-check (ACH) or Credit Card. Go to Your DEQ Online here: <https://ydo.oregon.gov>. Select Register Account or Login, then select Pay Invoices/Fees on your account dashboard. Enter the Invoice number and Account ID included on the attached payment slip. Note: US Bank charges a 2.3% convenience charge for credit card transactions. ACH payments have no additional charges.

Pay by check or money order: Make checks payable to "Department of Environmental Quality" and mail to the address on the enclosed payment slip. Please make sure to include the payment slip with your check or money order.
