Re: Notice of Civil Penalty Assessment and Order
No. WQ-SW-WR-2022-558

On July 7, 2023, you received a Notice of Civil Penalty Assessment and Order. Since you did not request a contested case hearing within the time allowed, the Order became final by operation of law. The Order requires you to pay \$8,000 civil penalty.

You may appeal the Order to the Oregon Court of Appeals as provided in ORS 183.482. If you do not file an appeal to the Oregon Court of Appeals within 60 days of the date of service of the Order, September 5, the civil penalty becomes due and payable 10 days after that date on September 15. If the civil penalty remains unpaid after that time, liens may be filed against any property you own. You will not be able to clear title of your property in a sale without paying the penalty plus interest. DEQ will also pursue collection of the penalty through other legal means.

If you do not intend to appeal, please promptly pay the \$8000 penalty as follows:
Pay online with e-check (ACH) or Credit Card. Go to Your DEQ Online here:
<https://ydo.oregon.gov>. Select Register Account or Login, then select Pay Invoices/Fees on your account dashboard. Enter the Invoice number and Account ID included on the attached payment slip. Note: US Bank charges a 2.3% convenience charge for credit card transactions. ACH payments have no additional charges.

Pay by check or money order: Make checks payable to "Department of Environmental Quality" and mail to the address on the enclosed payment slip. Please make sure to include the payment slip with your check or money order.
