New Source Air Quality Permitting

Your DEQ Online Submittal Guide

This fact sheet outlines the required Your DEQ Online submittals for new facilities seeking an air quality permit. Please contact [your regional DEQ office](#) to determine if a permit is required for your facility. For account setup, see [YDO Account Registration](#).



Which YDO submittals do I need to submit?

Three submittals are required in YDO for a new Simple or Standard Air Contaminant Discharge Permit (ACDP) application. These are: (1) the ACDP application; (2) the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) application; and (3) the NAAQS Analysis application.

Submittal #1: ACDP - Simple or Standard Permit Application

Submit either the "ACDP – Simple Permit Application" or "ACDP – Standard and Construction Permit Application" in YDO as applicable. For instructions on applying for ACDP permits, see the ACDP User Guides on the Air Quality Permitting [Getting Started Web Page](#). Permit application fees apply, see [OAR 340-216-8020 Table 2](#).

Submittal #2: CAO – New/Reconstructed Source Risk Assessment Application

Submit the "CAO – New/Reconstructed Source Risk Assessment Application" in YDO. The CAO submittal is the human health risk assessment component of air permit applications. For additional instruction on the CAO submittal, see the [CAO New/Reconstructed Application Guide](#). The "New Source Consulting Fee" applies, see [OAR 340-216-8030 Table 3](#).

Submittal #3: ACDP – Criteria Pollutant NAAQS Analysis

Submit the "ACDP – Criteria Pollutant NAAQS Analysis" submittal in YDO. Facilities must demonstrate compliance with NAAQS before obtaining an ACDP Permit. DEQ will not review your permit application until **all three submittals** have been submitted in YDO and **all applicable fees are paid**.

What if my facility is applying for a General or Basic ACDP?

CAO and NAAQS submittals are often not required for General or Basic ACDP Permits. If applying for a General or Basic ACDP, see [ACDP- General and Basic Permit Application Information](#). Permit application fees apply, see [OAR 340-216-8020 Table 2](#).

What if my facility is notifying DEQ about construction?

Complete a Notice of Construction (NC) submittal in YDO. To determine whether an NC is needed, contact a [Regional Permit Coordinator](#). Permit application fees apply, see "Notice of Intent to Construct Type 2 Fees" in [OAR 340-216-8020 Table 2](#).
