Adjusting our expectations

RLG withdrew its letter of intent in February, leaving only one prospective PRO with a letter of intent on file with the department. What does this mean for plan review?

- Only one plan to review
- No interim coordination/assignment of tasks
 - "Start Up" section replaces" Interim Coordination"
 - No awaiting assignment to initiate start up tasks

PRO Plan Review: Subcommittee approach

In December, DEQ recommended the formation of seven subcommittees for program plan review:

PRO Depots (collection and recycling of the PRO Recycling Acceptance List)

Ensuring responsible end markets

Education and outreach

Producer fees (base and graduated fees)

Equity

Every other week schedule

Public meetings of up to two hours

Role of DEQ staffers

- Resolve uncertainty as to program plan requirements and process
- Clarify DEQ recommendations
- Facilitate, note-take as desired by the subcommittee
